Parents, before classes start, we invite you to see *The Catechism of the Catholic Church* (§§ 1213-1497) on the basis and beauty of these sacraments. If you read it at www.usccb.org (under Resources), it is part 2, section 2, chapters 1-2. Of special note, "Children must go to the sacrament of Penance before receiving Holy Communion for the first time" (CCC § 1457).

If your family is not yet registered at St. Peter Parish, please also fill out a Family Registration Form. If you did one before but important information has changed, please do a new one.

As you fill out this form: Legal names as on Canadian ID are required. In case of adoption (let us know) give adoptive parent names. The mother's maiden name (that is, her name before she got married and changed her last name) will be used on the baptism certificate. **In some countries/cultures**, the family name (surname) is considered the first name, and a child's unique name in the family is considered the middle and/or last name. Using that order on forms here in Canada could cause important problems. **In Canada** the first part of a person's given name is the first name, and the surname is the last name.

* Like the parents, "**the sponsor** is to take care that the confirmed person behaves as a true witness of Christ and faithfully fulfills the obligations inherent in this sacrament" (Canon Law § 892). Sponsors must also be 17 years or older (unless the pastor makes an exception), and be baptised, confirmed, practicing Catholics "who lead a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on" (Canon Laws §§ 874, 893), which is to "help the baptized person to lead a Christian life in keeping with baptism..." (Canon Law §§ 872, 893). Confirmation sponsors can be the same as the child's godparents (note, only one or two are allowed), as long as they still meet the conditions outlined above. As indicated above, there may be one male and one female, not two males and not two females.
