* Like the parents, "the sponsor is to take care that the confirmed person behaves as a true witness of Christ and faithfully fulfills the obligations inherent in this sacrament" (Canon Law § 892). Sponsors must also be 17 years or older (unless the pastor makes an exception), and be baptised, confirmed, practicing Catholics "who lead a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on" (Canon Laws §§ 874, 893), which is to "help the baptized person to lead a Christian life in keeping with baptism..." (Canon Law §§ 872, 893). Confirmation sponsors can be the same as the child's godparents (note, only one or two are allowed), as long as they still meet the conditions outlined above. As indicated above, there may be one male and one female, not two males and not two females.
