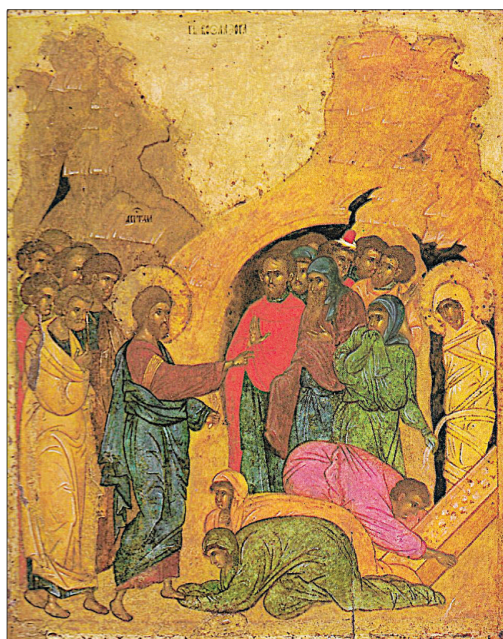

Dig Deep into the Gospel with Father James.

**“Lazarus, come out ...
Unbind him and let him go.” (John 11:43-44.)**

In John 5:25-28, Jesus made a claim to do what would prove that He is the Messiah. He said, “Very truly I tell you, a time is coming and has now come when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live” (John 5:25). In our Gospel text for this weekend, John 11:1-45, Jesus proves to all that He, the Messiah, can wake up the dead and bring them back to life.

On that momentous day, Jesus goes to Lazarus’ tomb and confronts an enemy He has come to overthrow – Death. Even though Lazarus had been dead for four days, Jesus called in a loud voice, “Lazarus, come out!” The dead man came out, his hands and feet wrapped with strips of linen, and a cloth around his face. Jesus said to them, “Take off the grave clothes, unbind him and let him go” (John 11:43-44). This command fulfils the promise of John 5:25.

Our Lenten journey is to the place of promise. Jesus will undo whatever has killed our spirits. He will command that we be freed from the shackles. The Jewish authorities strove to prevent this. They killed him. But that was not to be the end. The journey of Lent leads ultimately to the Resurrection.

The name Lazarus is from the Hebrew la‘zār, a rabbinic abbreviation of ‘el‘āzār, (Eleazar), meaning, "God has helped." He wants to help us. Be His friend, like Lazarus was Jesus’ friend. If we get close to Jesus, as Martha and Mary did, we too will hear those words that Jesus said to Martha: 'I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in Me will never die.' (John 11:25-26a). People who believe in Him will live -- even though they die (like Lazarus did), Jesus will raise them from death on the Last Day.

Some who give to St. Peter by e-transfer or auto-debit have asked for a way to donate to special collections outside our parish. Mini envelope sets are being made.

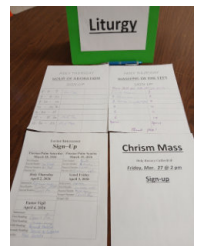
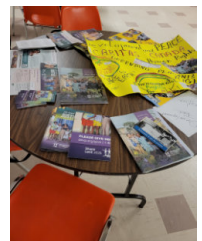
