Dig Deep into the Gospel with Father James.

**Emmaus: The Journey with Jesus
Through the Word to the Eucharist**

This Sunday's Gospel account, Luke 24:14-35, shows why we have the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist at every Mass. It shows their relationship to a great reception of His real presence.

At the start, we have two perplexed disciples journeying with Jesus, whom they supposed was a stranger, to Emmaus after His death and reported resurrection. They listened as He explained the scriptures to them. As He wiped out their ignorance, they came to trust Him. So they asked Him, "Stay with us... And He went in to stay with them" (24:29) In their spirits they more and more desired His presence. Their lives, out of control in their perplexity, were coming under control by Jesus.

Then when they sat with Jesus, and He took the bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it to them, they finally

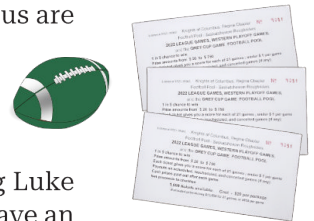

recognized Him (24:30-31). This was the Eucharist of the Church, which he had given first at the table of the Last Supper. This was the Word made flesh for them.

This is how we also experience the real presence of Jesus and its meaning. Like those disciples, whose hearts burned with joy at the truths He revealed (24:32), our hearts should do the same as we listen to the scriptures being opened to us. As their eyes opened to see His real presence in the breaking of the Bread, so should ours be when we are given Communion. The passage therefore establishes a pattern for our Eucharistic liturgical worship: the service of the Word (with explanation of the Scriptures) followed by the service of the Table (breaking of the Bread), where Christ is revealed to, and given to, His people.
