Happy Easter, Apr. 5

from Father James

This year's Easter Gospel reading is from John 20:1-18, and it helps us understand the reason why we are called to celebrate Easter. That which the Lord spoke through the prophet Isaiah has been fulfilled. Isaiah 52:13 states, "See, my servant will act wisely; He will be raised and lifted up and highly exalted." John 20:1-9 describes the discovery of Jesus' empty tomb on the Sunday morning of the day of the Resurrection. Mary Magdalene finds the stone removed, and runs to tell Peter and John, who both run to the tomb. They find the linen wrappings but not the body, and though they did not yet fully understand what scriptures said about the resurrection, the other disciple, John, sees and believes.

Mary's glance at the tomb and her departure from the tomb to go report reports to the disciples is the Easter greeting we offer to one another today: "He is risen as He said, Alleluia, Alleluia!" The resurrection occurred on "the first day of the week," (John 20:1-2), which is the reason why all Sundays throughout the year are the official miniature Easter Day. My prayer for all of us is that, like when Mary Magdalene arrived at the tomb, "the stone had been removed," may God roll away the stone blocking our faith and our family members, Amen.

Happy Easter – He is risen, Alleluia, Alleluia!



Divine Mercy Sunday, Apr. 12

*Wherever the Church gathers,
Jesus appears and is in their midst.*

In John 20:19-31, the risen Jesus appears where the disciples had gathered; He greets the disciples and shows them the marks of His crucifixion. The Mercy of God flowed from those wounds. After seeing His marks and recognizing Him as their Lord, the disciples rejoice.

Jesus greets them, saying, "Peace be with you" (John 20:19), after which Jesus commissions them with the words, "As the Father has sent Me, even so send I you" (John 20:21).

That gathering was of the church on Easter Sunday. The apostle Thomas, was absent from church on that day. When the others told him, "We have seen the Lord," he refused to believe. However, eight days after the resurrection, Jesus appears again, at the same gathering place, and grants Thomas permission to place his finger in His side, instructing him, "Put your fingers here and see My hands, and put out your hand, and place it in My side; and do not be faithless, but believing."

This is a call to us to believe in the Body and Blood of Christ.
