Dig Deep into the Gospel with Father James.

The Promise of the Paraclete and the Anointing that Flows to the Church

In our Gospel text for this Sunday, John 14:15-21, Jesus says that once He arrives in His heavenly glory, "I will ask the Father and He will give you another advocate, to be with you always." And it did happen on Pentecost Day. The Church always looks forward to Ascension Day next weekend) because Jesus leaves to fulfil this promise, so that the Church community can be anointed for its spiritual life, worship, and its role as it functions within the world.

It was Jesus' wish that we, His followers, keep His commandments – especially the celebration of the New Passover, the Holy Eucharist. He says, "Whoever has My commands and keeps them is the one who loves Me (v.21). Up until the time of Jesus, the people had kept the Exodus commandment, the Passover, given through

Moses. Jesus, before His departure, presents the new covenant – The Holy Eucharist. Unlike the Deuteronomic commandment that was given as Law, the New Covenant, which Jesus presents, is given as Love. The new commandment of Love is the rule of life for the new people of God under Christ – that is, the Church.

Jesus says: "If you love Me, keep my commands. And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Advocate to help you and be with you forever (v.15-16). The Holy Spirit that Jesus will send is the Counsellor, the Comforter. He will help the disciples, lead them to a deeper understanding of Jesus, and enable them to share in His eternal and resurrected life (you will live forever). This new relationship is achieved in Holy Communion. Jesus says, "You in me and I in you (John 14:20).

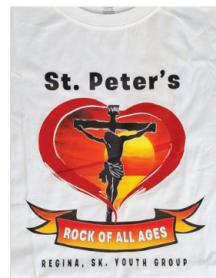
