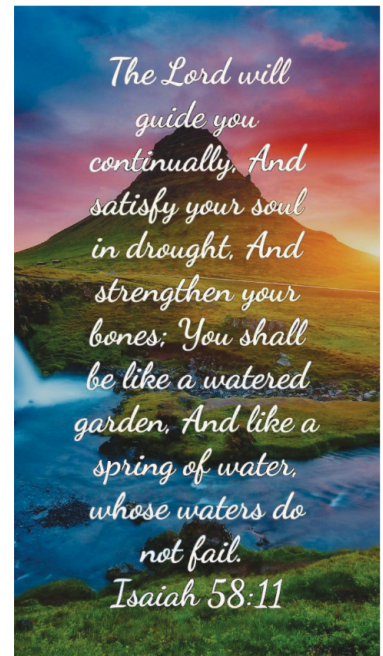
**The Parable of the Sower –
Jesus wishes spiritual growth for everyone**

In the parable of the Sower (Matthew 13: 1-23), the seed represents the Word of God. The Sower spread the seed indiscriminately and generously. Some fell on the path, others on rocky grounds, and still others amongst thorns, and then on good soil. The four kinds of soils represent the four conditions of the human heart.

From a deeper mystical understanding and interpretation, the seed represents Christ Himself—the divine "Word" of God who became flesh and was planted in the earth (at His death), to produce an eternal harvest (the resurrection). Just as the Sower broadcast the seed on all four types of soil, God's grace is universally offered. Christ was "planted" for each of us.

Jesus wishes spiritual growth for all souls, whatever their condition. But human beings retain the responsibility to cultivate their "soil" by uprooting the thorns, breaking up the hardened path, and removing the stones to ensure the seed can yield fruit.
